Grant funds pay for shelter improvements and upgrades

Having surpassed 20 years of operation, and almost 5,000 people sheltered, our buildings have started to show their age. With the receipt of funding from the Lindsay Legacy CHEST Fund and the Homeless Partnering Strategy, our shelter has been undergoing some improvements both functionally and aesthetically. A number of major issues have been resolved such as water damaged drywall, gutter and flashing repairs, as well as the repair of our building's exterior plaster. In the coming weeks we will be updating our courtyard to improve accessibility to our buildings and better direct water flow on our property.

We will also be installing a new awning on the front of our McMurray building. APCH has recently installed 24 new cameras on the property to improve the safety of both staff and residents.

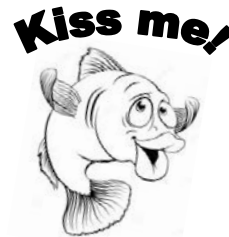
Youth Program Continues Providing Services to Youth in Need

The Youth Program at APCH serves an average of 32-34 clients each month. Our Youth Trustee works in partnership with Ontario Works by providing support to students who need assistance to achieve their educational goals, from maintaining high school attendance to high school graduation to applying for post-secondary education. It is not uncommon for the Trustee to attend meetings at OW and complete banking a number of times each week to ensure that clients are on the right track. Trustee services also include advocacy for youth and support via referrals to agencies that assist with mental health concerns. This program is making a positive difference in the lives of those who access services through the program.
